To: Parents/Guardians of the Pulaski County Virtual Academy

School Nutrition will be providing meals for all students enrolled in Pulaski County Virtual Academy beginning the first week of school, beginning Wednesday, September 9th, 2020. All students enrolled in the Pulaski County Virtual Academy are eligible to receive a breakfast and lunch meal for all scheduled instructional days.

The meals for Pulaski County's virtual learners will be available every Wednesday from 1:00pm - 2:00pm at all Pulaski County Schools. If you're unable to pick up during this time, we'll do our best to work with your schedule to ensure your child has access to the school meals.

Meals will consist of a minimum of the following items:

Breakfast: 2oz grain and/or protein, 1 cup fruit (juice and/or fresh, frozen or portioned) 8 oz milk

Lunch: 2oz protein, 2oz grain, ½ c. vegetable, ½ c. fruit and 8oz skim or 1% milk (white and/or chocolate)

Meal Availability Schedule:

Beginning Wednesday, September 9th, 2020, meals may be picked up at any school site. These meals will include five (5) breakfast and five (5) lunch meals for virtual learners. (These meals are for Wednesday-Friday and the following Monday & Tuesday.)

When picking up meals, the parent/guardian picking up the meals must provide the name of the students and the schools in which they are enrolled. For example, if you are picking up meals for two students and you pick up at Snowville Elementary. However, your students attend PCMS and PCHS, be sure to tell the Snowville staff this information upon pick up; PCPS School Nutrition needs this information for reporting purposes.

Parents are asked to order meals by using the following system:
