



To the Parent/Guardian:

Our local Lion's Club has purchased some new vision screening equipment and has offered to come to all Pulaski County Public Schools and provide vision screening for our students. The Lion's Club will work with our school nurses to coordinate the screenings.

The Spot Vision Screener is a portable hand held screener. It is non-invasive and screens from about 3 feet away. It is powered by sophisticated technology that quickly detects the indication of the following vision issues:

- Near-sightedness (myopia)
- Far-sightedness (hyperopia)
- Unequal refractive power (anisometropia)
- Blurred vision, eye structure problem (astigmatism)
- Pupil size deviations (anisocoria)
- Eye misalignment (strabismus)

Following the completion of screenings, parents/guardians will be notified about the need for follow-up with an eye care provider.

If you **do not** want your child to participate in the vision screening, please sign the consent form below and return it to your school nurse before August 19, 2016. All students will be screened if we do not receive this signed form by the above date.
