The local division superintendent will participate in each required triannual meeting and monitor, at a minimum, monthly progress of the essential actions. This includes implementing essential actions with fidelity and aligning all other work in the identified school with the essential actions. The local division superintendent will ensure that appropriate division and school staff participate fully in agreed upon technical assistance provided by the Virginia Department of Education. This agreement will remain in place until Pulaski Middle School is *Fully Accredited* or *Denied Accreditation*. Additional essential actions may be required by the State Superintendent.
