

# Dublin Elementary School

## Supply List 2017 - 2018

### Kindergarten

- 1 pair FISKAR brand scissors
- 6 large or 18 small glue sticks
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container of baby wipes or antibacterial wipes
- 1 large book bag (large enough for a towel and library book – no wheels please)
- 2 bottles of hand soap
- Girls – 1 box of quart sized freezer zip-lock bags
- Boys – 1 box gallon sized freezer zip-lock bags
- 1 towel for resting (not a mat)
- 1 pack Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 pack of four black Expo (dry erase) markers



### 1<sup>st</sup> Grade

- 1 box of quart-size freezer bags (boys)
- 1 box of gallon-size freezer bags (girls)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 large container or refill of baby wipes
- 1 pair of FISKAR brand scissors, labeled with your child's name
- 4 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons
- 12 Elmer's brand glue sticks
- 1 box of 24 count plain pencils (presharpened)
- 4 pack of **black** dry-erase markers
- 4 three prong vinyl folders with pockets (red, black, blue, green)
- 2 Pink Pearl erasers (please no pencil top erasers)
- 1 plastic pencil box (not a pencil pouch), labeled with your child's name
- 2 one-subject, wide-ruled spiral notebook, labeled with your child's name
- 1 one-inch binder, labeled with your child's name
- 1 hand sanitizer and liquid hand soap
- \*Unless noted above, do not label other supplies. Donations of additional supplies listed above are appreciated.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

- 1 large pencil bag (no boxes please)
- 1 pair of FISKAR scissors
- 2 boxes of 16 or 24 count crayons
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 box of #2 Ticonderoga pencils -sharpened please
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 pink pearl eraser
- 1 marbled composition notebook
- 1 box of baby wipes OR Clorox wipes
- 2 bottles of hand soap (foaming) or refill
- 1 box Gallon size zip-lock bags
- \*Please do not label supplies with your child's name.
- \*Please bring your supplies to open house.



### 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade

- 3 large boxes of tissues
- 4 dozen #2 pencils sharpened (no mechanical pencils or Dixon brand please)
- 1 large zippered pencil pouch (no boxes please)
- 1 pair of school scissors
- 4 Pink Pearl erasers
- 1 composition notebook
- 2 packages of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 4 boxes of crayons (24 count only, please)
- Girls: 1 container of wet baby wipes; Boys: 1 container of Clorox wipes
- 12 glue sticks
- 4 highlighters
- 4 Expo dry erase markers
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer and hand soap
- 7 three prong folders with pockets
- Boys: 1 box snack or sandwich zip-lock bags
- Girls: 1 box of quart or gallon zip-lock bags
- \*No large binders, please. Desk space is very limited.



### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

- 1 four function calculator to remain at school
- 1 pack of pencils
- 12 glue sticks
- 1 box of Crayons/colored pencils
- 2 highlighter markers
- 4 pack dry erase markers
- 2 packages of loose-leaf paper to begin the year
- Small school scissors
- 1 box baby wet wipes (girls)
- 1 container Clorox wipes (boys)
- 2 boxes of tissues to begin the year
- One 1-inch binder or larger
- 1 pack of tab dividers
- 1 pencil bag (no boxes)
- 2 three prong folders with pockets
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 hand sanitizer
- 1 pack sheet/page protectors
- \*Please only send enough supplies for your child to start the year. Please label your child's supplies before bringing them to school. If no name is on the supplies they will go in a community box. Please store the rest at home until needed.

### Fifth Grade 2017-2018

- 1 1 ½ inch 3 ring binder
- 1 package of dividers with pockets
- 5 folders with prongs and pockets for each 9 weeks.  
(The plastic ones last longer)
- Regular pencils – no mechanical pencils please
- 4 packs of loose-leaf paper (purchase more as needed)
- 3 large boxes of tissues per semester
- Small box of crayons –16 or less (The twist-up kind last longer.)
- Pencil bag – no pencil boxes please
- Glue sticks
- 1 pair small scissors
- 1 small hand sanitizer
- 1 book bag
- 1 pair of inexpensive earbuds to leave a school
- 2 Containers of Clorox wipes
- 2 highlighters
- \*Please do not bring pencil boxes, mechanical pencils, or pens.
