

RIVERLAWN ELEMENTARY SUPPLY LIST 2017-2018

PRE-K: Mrs. Burkhart's Class

- * One STANDARD/LARGE size book bag- (no wheels, no mini back packs)
*This book bag needs to be able to hold a folder, towels/clothes, library book, and large crafts at the same time!
- * One complete change of clothing.
*Please put in a gallon size zip-lock bag labeled with your child's name. Please include underwear and socks. This will also need to be updated to coordinate with the weather.
- * One beach towel or small blanket for rest time (optional)
- * Two containers of Clorox/Lysol disinfecting wipes
- * One box of tissues
- * One large package of Elmer's glue sticks (purple glue only)
- *
- * **BOYS-** One box of SANDWICH size zip-lock bags
One bottle of hand sanitizer
- * **GIRLS-**One box GALLON size zip lock bags
One roll of paper towels

PRE-K: Mrs. Clay's Class

- * Some type of book bag/back pack large enough to carry folders and supplies to/from school
- * 3 boxes of tissues (you may be asked to send more later in the year)
- * 1 complete change of clothes to keep at school (please include socks and underwear and **have your child's name written on the tags**)
- * 1 crib sheet for the cot and a towel or blanket for naptime
- * 3 rolls of paper towels
- * 3 containers of disinfectant wipes
- * 1 pack of paper plates
- * A regular supply of diapers and wipes if your child is not yet potty trained

KINDERGARTEN

- * 1 single subject spiral bound notebook
- * 1 red and 1 green pocket folder (PLASTIC)
- * 1 family size box of tissues
- * 9 glue sticks (will need replacing during the year)
- * 2 boxes of regular Crayola crayons (24count)-will need replacing during the year
- * 1 pair of Fiskar scissors -blunt point
- * 1 container of baby wipes
- * 1 plastic pencil box
- * 1 water color paint (8 count colors)
- * 1 box of washable markers
- * 1 pack of EXPO markers
- * A bath towel will be needed for rest time- (no mats or beach towels as we do not have the storage space). **(LABEL WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME)**
- * **BOYS**—gallon freezer bags, play-doh 4 pack, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer or hand soap, 1 pack of paper plates (no styrofoam)
- * **GIRLS**—sandwich size bags, 1 container disinfectant wipes, 1 pack of brown or white lunch bags, 1 pack of paper towels
- * Tennis shoes will be needed for Physical Education classes. A schedule will be sent home stating your child's P.E. schedule.
- * A large backpack to carry belongings (will need to bring to school daily).
- * We ask that you do not buy or send paper or pencils as these will be provided for them. Your child may receive an additional supply list from their classroom teacher.

FIRST GRADE

- * A backpack
- * 4 boxes of 24 count crayons (no larger)
- * A pair of scissors (Fiskars are best)
- * 9 solid clear glue sticks (not liquid)
- * 2-3subject spiral bound notebook (120 sheets)- Wide Rule not college ruled
- * 20- #2 natural wood pencils
- * 1 box zip lock gallon freezer bags
- * Boys-1 box zip lock quart freezer bags or sandwich bags
- * Girls- one box snack size zip lock bags
- * 2 family size boxes of tissues
- * 1 boxes of wet wipes
- * 1 dry erase marker
- * 1 green plastic folder
- * 1 red plastic folder
- * Boys- broadline markers
- * Girls- fine line markers
- * 1-hand sanitizer
- * 1 set inexpensive headphones

As there is much to be done in first grade, the following supplies will need to be replaced many times during the school year so you may want to stock up on the following items: crayons, glue sticks and pencils. In addition to these items, your child's teacher may ask for other supplies. Please **do not** write your child's name on supplies. Most items are shared.

SECOND GRADE

- * 1 containers of wipes
- * 2 boxes of tissues
- * 2 pkg. cap erasers
- * 2 highlighters
- * 1 pkg. of dry erase markers
- * 8 glue sticks
- * 1 pack of #2 yellow, wooden, sharpened pencils
- * 3 boxes of 24 count crayons
- * 2 pairs of scissors
- * 1 pencil box or pouch
- * 2 composition notebooks (no spiral)
- * 1 green plastic 3-prong folder
- * 1 yellow plastic folder
- * Boys: 1 Box of Ziploc gallon bags
- * Girls: 1 Box of Ziploc quart bags
- * \$5.00 for Weekly Reader

Supplies do not need to be labeled.

THIRD GRADE

- * 2- 1" three ring binders
- * 4 plastic 2 pocket folders with prongs
- * 10- 3 pronged pocket folders (2 orange, 2 red, 2 yellow, 2 blue, 2 green)
- * 1-wide-ruled spiral (composition) notebook
- * 1-Paperback Student Dictionary
- * 4 packs wide-ruled loose leaf paper
- * 4 packages of #2 yellow wooden pencils (no mechanical or decorative pencils please)
- * 2 packages of pencil head erasers
- * 8 glue sticks for class collection
- * Crayons (16 or 24 count)
- * 6 highlighters
- * 1 pair of school scissors
- * Large fabric pencil bag
- * 2 regular size boxes of tissues
- * 1 package of post-it notes
- * Girls- antibacterial wipes
- * Boys- sandwich size zip lock bags

FOURTH GRADE

- * Book bag (No rolling wheels)
- * 3-4 packs of wide ruled loose-leaf paper
- * 2-3 regular or large size boxes of tissues
- * 6 folders w/prongs (different colors if possible)
- * 3-1.5" binders
- * Boys-gallon size zip-lock bags
- * Boys-disinfecting wipes
- * Girls-quart size zip-lock bags
- * Girls-baby wipes
- * 1 pack of cap erasers (for classroom use)
- * 1 pack of dry erase markers (for classroom use)
- * 1 container of Hand Sanitizer
- * **1 large or 2 small soft pencil bags (no boxes) containing the following items:**
- * #2 pencils
- * 1 package 12-24 colored pencils or crayons
- * 2 red ballpoint pens
- * 3 highlighters (different colors)
- * 2 glue sticks
- * 1 pair scissors
- * 1 hand held pencil sharpener with container for shavings
- * 1 clean sock (can be used) for student dry erase boards

(You may want to buy extra folders while on sale, as well as pencil bag items. These will need to be replaced periodically throughout the year.)
