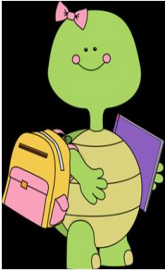


# RIVERLAWN ELEMENTARY SUPPLY LIST 2018-2019



## Riverlawn Elementary School Preschool Supply List 2018-2019

\*regular size backpack (No small backpacks or backpacks with wheels please. This book bag needs to be able to hold a 3-ring binder, towels/clothes, library book, and large crafts at the same time!)

- \* 1 - box of baby wipes (or refills)
- \* 2 - rolls of paper towels
- \* 1 - pack of index cards
- \* 1 - pack of paper plates (boys)
- \* 1 - pack of Styrofoam bowls (girls)
- \* 2 - containers of Clorox/Lysol disinfecting wipes
- \* 1 - box of tissues
- \* 1 - complete change of clothing (Please include underwear and socks. This will also need to be updated to coordinate with the weather. )

**\*\*\*pencils, crayons, glue sticks, and scissors to keep and use at home\*\*\***

## KINDERGARTEN

- \* 1 single subject spiral bound notebook
- \* 1 red and 1 green pocket folder (PLASTIC)
- \* 1 family size box of tissues
- \* 9 glue sticks (will need replacing during the year)
- \* 2 boxes of regular Crayola crayons (24count)-will need replacing during the year
- \* 1 pair of Fiskar scissors -blunt point
- \* 1 container of baby wipes
- \* 1 plastic pencil box
- \* 1 water color paint (8 count colors)
- \* 1 box of washable markers
- \* 1 pack of EXPO markers
- \* A bath towel will be needed for rest time- (no mats or beach towels, as we do not have the storage space). **(LABEL WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME)**
- \* **BOYS**—gallon freezer bags, play-doh 4 pack, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer or hand soap, 1 pack of paper plates (no styrofoam)
- \* **GIRLS**—sandwich size bags, 1 container disinfectant wipes, 1 pack of brown or white lunch bags, 1 pack of paper towels
- \* Tennis shoes will be needed for Physical Education classes. A schedule will be sent home stating your child's P.E. schedule.
- \* A large backpack to carry belongings (will need to bring to school daily).
- \* We ask that you do not buy or send paper or pencils as these will be provided for them. Your child may receive an additional supply list from their classroom teacher.

## FIRST GRADE

- \* A backpack
- \* A plastic pencil box
- \* 4 boxes of 24 count crayons (no larger)
- \* A pair of scissors (Fiskars are best)
- \* 9 solid clear glue sticks (not liquid)
- \* 2-3 subject spiral bound notebook (120 sheets)- Wide Rule not college ruled
- \* 20- #2 natural wood pencils
- \* 1 box zip lock gallon freezer bags
- \* Boys-1 box zip lock quart freezer bags or sandwich bags
- \* Girls- one box snack size zip lock bags
- \* 2 family size boxes of tissues
- \* 1 box of wet wipes
- \* 1 dry erase marker
- \* 1 green plastic folder
- \* 1 red plastic folder
- \* Boys- broadline markers
- \* Girls- fine line markers
- \* 1-hand sanitizer
- \* 1 set inexpensive headphones

As there is much to be done in first grade, the following supplies will need to be replaced many times during the school year so you may want to stock up on the following items: crayons, glue sticks and pencils. In addition to these items, your child's teacher may ask for other supplies. Please **do not** write your child's name on supplies. Most items are shared.

## SECOND GRADE

- \* 1 container unscented/regular hand sanitizer
- \* 2 containers of wipes
- \* 2 boxes of tissues
- \* 2 pkg. cap erasers
- \* 1 highlighter
- \* 1 pkg. of dry erase markers
- \* 1 pkg. index cards
- \* 8 glue sticks
- \* 1 pack of #2 yellow, wooden, sharpened pencils
- \* 3 boxes of 24 count crayons
- \* 1 pair of scissors
- \* 1 pencil box or pouch
- \* 2 composition notebooks (no spiral)
- \* 1 green plastic 3-prong folder
- \* 1 red plastic 3 prong folder
- \* Boys: 1 Box of Ziploc gallon bags
- \* Girls: 1 Box of Ziploc quart bags
- \* \$6 for Scholastic News

If you would like to donate extra supplies, we could use the following: markers, Clorox wipes, card stock paper (8 ½"x11" size) and any extra of the supply items listed above.

**Supplies do not need to be labeled.**

## THIRD GRADE

- \* 2- 1" three ring binders
- \* 5- 3 pronged pocket folders (one of each color: red, yellow, blue, green, and orange)
- \* 2-wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- \* 1 pkg. of wide-ruled loose leaf paper
- \* 1 pkg. pink wedge erasers
- \* 4 highlighters
- \* 1 pkg. of dry erase markers
- \* 10 glue sticks
- \* 2 packages of #2 yellow wooden pencils (no mechanical pencils please)
- \* 2 boxes of crayons (16 or 24 count)
- \* 1 pair of scissors
- \* 1 pencil box or pouch
- \* 2 boxes of tissues
- \* 1 container of wipes
- \* \$6.00 for Scholastic News
- \* If you would like to donate extra supplies, we could use the following: Ziploc bags: sandwich and gallon size, color copy paper, hand sanitizer, and extra of the supply items listed above.

## FOURTH GRADE

- \* Book bag (No rolling wheels)
- \* 3-4 packs of wide ruled loose-leaf paper
- \* 2-3 regular or large size boxes of tissues
- \* 6 folders w/prongs (different colors if possible)
- \* 3-1.5" binders
- \* 2 packs of 8 tabbed set of binder dividers
- \* Boys-gallon size zip-lock bags
- \* Boys-disinfecting wipes
- \* Girls-quart size zip-lock bags
- \* Girls-baby wipes
- \* 1 pack of cap erasers (for classroom use)
- \* 1 pack of dry erase markers (for classroom use)
- \* 1 container of Hand Sanitizer
- \* **1 large or 2 small soft pencil bags (no boxes) containing the following items:**

*(Please label the following items with your child's name)*

- \* #2 pencils
- \* 1 package 12-24 colored pencils or crayons
- \* 2 red ballpoint pens
- \* 3 highlighters (different colors)
- \* 2 glue sticks
- \* 1 pair scissors
- \* 1 hand held pencil sharpener with container for shavings
- \* 1 clean sock (can be used) for student dry erase boards

Please do not put paper or anything else in the binders or folders, we will set these up at the beginning of ES school. (You may want to buy extra folders while on sale, as well as pencil bag items. These will need to be replaced periodically throughout the year.)

If you would like to donate extras of anything on the list above to our classroom, it would be appreciated.

The following items would also be beneficial: Washable markers, adhesive page reinforcements and paper towels.

## FIFTH GRADE

- 1-3 subject spiral notebook Math
- \* 1-3 ring binders (1") Reading
- \* 1-3 ring binder (2") Science
- \* 1 Blue plastic folders with pockets and prongs-Writing
- \* 2-plastic folder with pockets and prongs-Social Studies/Science
- \* 1-Marble Covered Journal Composition Notebook-Writing Class
- \* 1 large boxes of tissues
- \* 3 packs of #2 pencils
- \* 2 packs of cap erasers
- \* 1 pencil pouch (No pencil boxes)
- \* 3 packs loose leaf paper (wide ruled)
- \* 2 packs of colored pencils (12 count)
- \* 8 yellow highlighters
- \* 6-8 glue sticks
- \* 1 pack of index cards
- \* 1 pack dry erase markers
- \* 1 pack of post it notes
- \* Boys-1 box of gallon zip lock bags and 1 container of baby wipes
- \* Girls-2 boxes of quart zip lock bags
- \* **No markers, pens, gel pens, mechanical pencils, pencil sharpeners or fidget spinners will be allowed.**
